Participants observed the massive infrastructure used to assemble, test, transport, and launch rockets—a rare glimpse into the rigorous preparation that ensures mission success.

Describing the experience as "once-in-a-lifetime opportunity," the winners expressed their admiration for ISRO's innovation, precision, and commitment to national progress. Many participants shared that the visit strengthened their resolve to pursue careers in science, engineering, and research.

ISRO's relentless pursuit of innovation and global collaboration is shaping India into a prominent leader in the global space ecosystem. Under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, it continues to scale new heights in space science and technology with landmark missions such as Aditya-L1, Gaganyaan, and upcoming interplanetary explorations.
