- Farm-to-Fork Market Linkages: Price forecasting, assaying, quality grading, traceability, and digital marketplaces.
- **Financial Inclusion & Insurance:** AI-driven credit assessments, parametric insurance, and livelihood security tools

Entries are invited to contribute a chapter to the Compendium, scheduled to be unveiled at the India-AI Impact Summit 2026 scheduled to be held from 15th- 20th February 2026 at the Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi.
