



India AI Impact Pre-Summit Workshop at Kavaratti highlights relevance of AI in improving governance of Island ecosystem

Kavaratti, Lakshadweep: As a pre-cursor to the global India AI Impact Summit 2026, an awareness workshop on AI and Digital India initiatives was conducted by the National e-Governance Division (NeGD), under the Ministry of Electronics & IT, in partnership with the State Department of Information Technology (LITSS) on February 2, 2026 at Kavaratti.

The workshop, conducted in liaison with the State Education Department, witnessed enthusiastic participation from schools, colleges and training centres across the islands of Lakshadweep. Around 300 people attended the workshop at Kavaratti, while more than 100 people watched the webcast of the programme from Androth Island.
