• GPF Annual Statements now available to Manipur Government Employees on DigiLocker

Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Manipur enables digital issuance of annual General Provident Fund account statements

Imphal, August 24, 2026: The Office of the Principal Accountant General (Accounts and Entitlements), Manipur, functioning under the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, has enabled the issuance of General Provident Fund (GPF) Annual Statements through DigiLocker. Subscribers whose GPF accounts are maintained by the Office of the Principal Accountant General can now obtain their annual statement of account in digital form through their DigiLocker accounts.

The GPF Annual Statement is the authoritative record of a subscriber's opening balance, subscriptions, withdrawals, interest credited and closing balance for the financial year. It is relied upon by employees for verification of credits, advance and withdrawal applications and retirement planning. Statements issued through DigiLocker are generated from the accounts maintained by the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E) and carry the digital signature of the issuing authority.

This arrangement removes the need for a subscriber to trace a physical statement, address a request to the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E) or await dispatch. It further eliminates the need to retain a paper copy for future reference.

How subscribers can access the statement

1. Sign in to DigiLocker through the mobile application or the web portal
2. Search for the GPF Annual Statement service listed under the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Manipur
3. Enter the identifying particulars sought, including the GPF account number and the financial year required
4. Fetch the statement. Once fetched, it remains available under Issued Documents for repeated access

At a glance

Earlier: trace the physical statement → address a request to the Office → await dispatch → retain a paper copy

Now: open DigiLocker → select the GPF Annual Statement service → fetch digitally → retrieve whenever required

What changes for the subscriber

- **Access on demand:** The statement can be retrieved at any time from a mobile phone or a computer
- **Authoritative and verifiable:** The statement is issued directly by the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E) maintaining the account and can be verified electronically by any recipient that accepts DigiLocker documents
- **No paper handling:** Printing, dispatch and physical retention of statements are avoided
- **Retrieval without correspondence:** Subscribers need not address requests to the Office for routine copies of the annual statement
- **Sharing on consent:** A statement is shared only at the subscriber's initiative and through the consent framework of the platform

About DigiLocker

DigiLocker is a Digital India initiative implemented by the National e-Governance Division under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. It enables individuals to receive documents and certificates issued directly by government departments and other authorised issuers in digital form and to share them with requesting organisations with their consent. Documents issued through DigiLocker carry the digital signature of the issuing authority and are treated at par with the corresponding original physical documents under the Information Technology (Preservation and Retention of Information by Intermediaries Providing Digital Locker Facilities) Rules, 2016.
